

<p><b>Massachusetts Waste Ban 310 CMR 19 Items</b></p>	<p>The Massachusetts D.E.P. has banned the following items from <u><b>ALL landfills and transfer stations</b></u>. If any of these waste ban items are placed in a dumpster, the following per item handling charges apply for all Transfer &amp; Recycling operations in the State of Massachusetts.</p>
<p><b>CRTs (Cathode Ray Tubes)</b></p> <p><b>Television screens</b> <b>Computer screens</b></p>	<p>Television and Computers</p>
<p><b>Mattresses</b></p>	<p>Mattress (DTM) Difficult to Manage charge</p>
<p><b>Propane Tanks</b></p>	<p>Propane Tanks</p>

<p><b>Appliances Containing Freon</b></p>	<p>Appliances such as Air Conditioners, Refrigerators, Freezers, Dehumidifiers etc.</p>
